RISK

No deodorizer and may have slip and fall risk

Red Biohazard Bags

RISK

Red bags require costly hazardous waste pickup and may unsettle customers and employees

Black Trash Bags



Disinfected and solidified body fluids can be disposed of in regular trash

Partial Coverage Gown

Gloves

RISK

Leaves some clothing exposed and increases cross-contamination risk to employees

Hair Net

Face Mask & Eye Shield

Full Gown & Thumb Loops

Gloves

Waterproof Shoe Covers



Complete employee protection from head to toe

SAFETY



Thin, Unsteady Plastic
 Scoop and Scraper

RISK

Employee comes into closer contact with body fluids

Heavy-Duty Cardboard
 Scraper and Dustpan
 with Handles



Easier to use and further away from contaminate
